KINGSMEAD MINI POLICE WIN NATIONAL AWARD

The MINI POLICE is youth engagement program that is aimed towards YEAR 5 children (9 and 10 years old) which enables them to work alongside their local policing team.

The MINI POLICE programme was introduced to NORTHWICH POLICE back in 2022, with HARTFORD SCHOOL being the first MINI POLICE team set up.

September 2023 the programme was rolled out to 2 more schools which included—KINGSMEAD and RUDHEATH. Each school was doing their own work which helped with community issues.

PCSO ROBERTSON was working with the KINGSMEAD MINI POLICE on:

- parking
- Speeding
- Bike Marking
- Safeguarding Advice
- Events

Due to their work that they were achieving, the KINGSMEAD MINI POLICE were invited to attend a ceremony at POLICE HEADQUARTERS in Winford and met with Mark Roberts (CHIEF CONSTABLE) Dan Price (POLICE CRIME COMMISSIONER) and Clare Hayward (CHESHIRE HIGH SHERIFF).

Due to their impact they were then invited to a further ceremony at CHESTER CATHODRAL by the High Sheriff.

With all schools that were taking part in the programme , KINGSMEAD was the first school to achieve a full year and then move into a 2nd year in which the MINI POLICE would help PCSO ROBERTSON select new MINI POLICE.

Due to everything that they had achieved over the 15 months that they were MINI POLICE , the 2023/2024 officers were nominated for an award at the CRIMEBEAT NATIONAL AWARDS, back in JANUARY 2025. And then invited to attend the ceremony, which was being held in LONDON in MARCH 2025.

At the awards the MINI POLICE presented a 7 minute long presentation , infront of other nominees , HIGH JUDGES

Matthew Ward (Deputy Chief Constable of the MET POLICE) High Sheriffs and other VIP.

After the presentation which spoke about all they work they done , which included Designing their own parking tickets and the MINI POLICE COURT which amazed many in attendance it was announced that the MINI POLICE had won.

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

Report in regards to possible harassment from housing group in relation to the welfare of animals being kept by reporting person

2nd Report in regards to issues between tenant and housing group.

- PCSO ROBERTSON is working with the housing group and there is concern about the welfare of the animals that the tenant is keeping with inside the property. The housing group / landlords are trying to provide support to the occupants and are just doing their job. PCSO ROBERTSON will speak to the reporting person in regard to this. PCSO ROBERTSON has been asked not to contact the reporting person anymore , therefore will work with housing group to see how we progress with this issue.

Report in regards to a safety of a friends partner due to receiving a message about hurting himself

- RESPONSE officers dispatched and spoke to the friend of reporting person and their partner. Safeguarding has been put into place and contacts given for support

Report of an OFFROAD bike spotted in THE CRESCENT area

- No further info given , PCSO ROBERTSON tried to contact reporting person to obtain further info, but no contact. Patrols will be put into the area to see if we can witness anything.

Report in regards to advice needed due to a relation ship breakdown

- Safeguarding advice given

Report of USED OIL being stolen from the rear of THE BOWLING GREEN

- Crimed

LEFTWICH

ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN

Report in regards to a MALE entering gardens and looking at properties

- **further call from reporting person to state that the male has left**

Report in regards to offensive gestures and remarks made from a neighbour

- **RESPONSE dispatched and aware of the ongoing issues that there is between the two neighbours—PC BOX and PCSO ROBERTSON have been made that there are new issues and are happy with the advice that PC who attended provided**

Report of a MALE being pushed and assaulted by the CLIFTON ROAD SHOPS

- **RESPONSE dispatched and being investigated**

Report of YOUTHS being on top of the LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING ROOF

2nd Report in regards to youths being on the LEFTWICH COMMUNITY BUILDING ROOF

- **RESPONSE officers dispatched , search made no trace. PCSO ROBERTSON has been made aware of issue of the fencing, so he can contact CWAC**

Report in regards to threats being made against REPORTING PERSONS relatives , attending and damaging their home

- **RESPONSE officers attended address and spoke to REPORTING PERSON. Spoke about the issue that lead to this and reporting person states that will ignore further calls / messages. Safeguarding advice given if there are further issues.**

Report of a neighbour being aggressive in regards to building work.

- **RESPONSE officers have spoken to REPORTING PERSON and have viewed CCTV. There has been previous issues from the neighbour which PCSO ROBERTSON has dealt with , therefore this issue is being passed over to PC BOX to look into. PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct a reassurance visit to see if there is any further issues.**

Report of 2 MALES and 1 FEMALE fighting on LONDON ROAD and smashing glass

- **RESPONSE dispatched , area searched and there were no signs of a fight or any smashed glass**

Report of a MALE shouting at and threatening children as they are playing football nearby

- **RESPONSE officers dispatched**

Report of a FEMALE KNOCKING on reporting persons door and asking for a HOODIE, as they are cold. Once a Hoodie has been given , 2 MALES and 1 FEMALE come and meet her, which reporting person thinks is suspicious

- **Nothing to deploy to**

Report of a FEMALE walking on LONDON ROAD looking confused and with nothing on her feet—

- **RESPONSE officers dispatched and female located and taken home**

Report of FIREWORKS going off in area , but whilst on phone changed it to GROUP OF YOUTHS kicking a ball against shop shutters

- **No deployment , no further calls**

Report of possible drug dealing in a location near to the reporting persons premises.

- **PCSO ROBERTSON , PC COLLECT and PC BAXTER are aware of this and aware of the male that may be connected to this and are investigating this. PCSO ROBERTSON will be in touch with reporting person to build a INTEL LINK with them**

Report of an assault outside of the LEFTWICH SHOPS

- **RESPONSE officers dispatched and spoke to the VICTIM who was obstructive to the officers who were trying to obtain all details. Refused to go to hospital or for officers to take him, due to him having a split lip**

Report of a child walking around on the streets on his own

- **RESPONSE dispatched and parents located.**

LEFTWICH

ASB / CAUSED FOR CONCERN (cont)

Report in regards to suspicious activity , as there was a door knock in the early hours which was ignored and then car was found with DUCK TAPE on it

- **PCSO ROBERTSON / PC BOX has been made aware and will conduct a REASSURANCE VISIT**

Report in regards to a MALE banging on window and demanding for his dog back in the early hours

- **RESPONSE officers dispatched—Male not in area when arrived at scene. PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct a reassurance visit**

Report in regards to an explosion within a back garden of neighbours to the reporting person. The neighbours do have a fire in the back garden.

- No other calls in relation to this , PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct reassurance visit**

Report of a STUDENT making up a fake SNAPCHAT account to send an explicit image of someone else around.

- **PCSO ROBERTSON will contact school contact to discuss this**

Report of a childrens toy being taken off them by a cyclist , after if hit them

- **No details of who the cyclist was**

CRIMINAL DAMAGE

Report in regards to damage being done to reporting persons vehicle

- **has been crimed. Awaiting to see if CCTV is available**

ROAD RELATED OFFENCE

Report of TWO MALES riding dangerously on a MOPED

- RESPONSE dispatched , Search made no trace. Spoke to numerous people in area and they had not seen the vehicle**

Report of a Vehicle being driven dangerously

- **RESPONSE officers dispatched. Search made no trace. Vehicle details have been given and processed as INTEL. PCSO ROBERTSON has been provided more information in regards to activities of this vehicle and will work with PC BOX to issue a warning**

Report of a Vehicle possibly being driven by a person without a full driving licence

2nd Report in regards to the same vehicle being driven

- **Information for the vehicle has been given and therefore passed to Police Officers if witnessed being driven**

Report of a MALE RIDING A OFFROAD BIKE on CLIFTON DRIVE

- **No BEAT OFFICERS available or DRONES. PCSO ROBERTSON will make contact with reporting person to obtain more information**

PARKING OBSTRUCTIONS

Report off a vehicle parked too close to the JUNCTION of LONDON ROAD on PRIORY AVE

2nd report in regards to a vehicle parked too close to JUNCTION

- **Area is known by PCSO ROBERTSON to have parking issues and is on his PATROL PLAN. PCSO DONNELLY has attended due to PCSO ROBERTSON not on duty and has issued a FIXED PENALTY NOTICE to the Vehicle.**

HIGHWAY OBSTRUCTION

Report of a vehicle driving at speed

- **This vehicle has other reports against it. Please see above**

Report in regards to reporting persons daughter receiving threatening messages on WHATSPP.

- Safeguarding advice has been given

Report in regards to reporting persons son having a SEIZURE and therefore smashing items

- Not a police issue , therefore no deployment

Report in regards to a MALE being DRUNK and being AGGRESSIVE

- RESPONSE officers dispatched and **MALE ARRESTED**

Report in regards to a WHITE FORD TRANSIT in area driven around suspiciously

- RESPONSE officers dispatched. Search of the area made, no trace. Information provided has been submitted as INTEL

Report of another vehicle being driven suspiciously.

- ANPR has been checked of the vehicle and was last hit in STOKE ON TRENT. No further calls.

Report in regards to a GROUP OF YOUTHS causing issues behind BARNADOES

- YOUTHS were chased off by REPORTING PERSON , RESPONSE officers dispatched, search made no trace of the youths. Spoke to reporting person and advised if there were further issues to call 101. PCSO ROBERTSON is aware of issues in area and has the area on PATROL PLAN.

Report in regards to a FEMALE possibly being given something by a MALE and is frothing at the mouth -

- Incident occurred at a party which could be a possible spiking. The parents were present at the party, and after speaking to all present, MALE who is a friend gave FEMALE went into toilet together (which was not questioned at the time) and gave FEMALE a pill. FEMALE sent to LEIGHTON HOSPITAL

Report in regards to a SON ASSAULTING both parents , after being refused extra time on IPAD and not allowed to leave the home

- REPONSE officers have attended and spoke to all parties. After speaking to all , parents stated that they did not want to make a complaint

Report of MALE smashing the flat up

- RESPONSE officers dispatched and have spoken to two males who have been in the flat, there is no sign of damaged , but have advised if further calls , there will be appropriate action .

Report of a MALE filling up his van , with a big load of water from the FIRE HYDRANT on SHAVINGTON WAY

Further report that may be linked to last report, as another males in similar van was in are a looking at properties

- There was no other reports in regards to the FIRE HYDRANT , so information has been passed to local community team. However PCSO ROBERTSON will contact reporting person , due to the 2nd report that they made

Report in regards to a male threatening to hurt themselves

- RESPONSE officers dispatched and all parties spoken. Officers happy that there was no cause for concern due to the threat was made in relation to an argument

Report in regards to damage that has been done to reporting persons door

- Reporting person was having a party which got out of control. PCSO ROBERTSON will try and contact reporting person as this is now the 5th issue since moving in. If he can not get in touch , he will contact the landlords

Reports in regards to youths snapping items of trees and bushes and throwing them into the DUCK POND by DUKES WAY

- PCSO ROBERTSON has been provided information in relation to this. Will speak to reporting person and informant and then will progress this further by trying to do home visits to all those concerned.

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

Report in regards to a possible harassment from a MALE

- PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct a reassurance visit

THEFT FROM MOTOR VEHICLE

Report stating that back plates of number plate and been unscrewed, has CCTV but there is no footage

- CRIMED

THEFT

Report stating that two bikes had been taken from outside TESCO. Whilst on call bikes were returned to owners

- No deployment

Report of shoplifting from TESCO , male is a frequent offender

- RESPONSE officers have attended—obtained description and completed a area search. MALE matching description with exact items located and **MALE ARRESTED**

Report of a MALE shoplifting and taking £100 of steak from TESCO

- CCTV has been captured and will be requested. PCSO ROBERTSON will visit to view the CCTV to see if he recognizes the male

Report on a MALE shoplifting , unknown what items have been taken, brief description given

- Unsure if it is the same MALE as above , CCTV is available. Again PCSO will visit to see if he recognizes the male

PARKING OBSTRUCTIONS

Report off numerous vehicles parked behind the shops and entrance way to school to access the doctors and is chaotic

- PCSO ROBERTSON has been made aware of this and will patrol the area at the weekends to see if this issue arises again.

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

Report from AMBULANCE in regards to a MALE who has been located on street not breathing and reporting person is performing CPR.

- INVESTIGATION has taken place and CCTV has been captured of the MALE and what leads up to this. There were no other persons present when the male collapses onto the ground

Report of youths taking residents cones from the area

Has been caught on CCTV, therefore PCSO ROBERTSON will view the CCTV to see if we can identify whos involved

Report in regards to reporting person had locked themselves out when baby was alone in the house.

Entry had been gained

Report of 2 vehicles parking up and the occupants of both vehicles acting strange.

The information that has been passed , has been processed as INTEL. PCSO ROBERTSON will call reporting person for reassurance and patrols will be on look out for the vehicles.

Report of a tyre possibly being SLASHED

—Crimed

Report of damage to a vehicle parked on reporting persons driveway. Roof slate has hit bonnet and damaged bonnet and window -

- Crimed , PCSO ROBERTSON will conducted a reassurance visit

THEFT

Report of a MALE taking items off shelf and then paying only for fuel—

- Crimed

Report of a MALE entering store and taking approx £40 of items

- Crimed—MALE has been **ARRESTED** and is linked to THEFTS in KINGSMEAD

Report of a CLOTHES MAIDEN being taken out of reporting persons back garden

- Crimed , No CCTV in area

ASB / CAUSE FOR CONCERN

Report in regards to a FEMALE shouting abuse at the reporting person

- **RESPONSE officers tried to contact reporting person but would not engage fully. There was previous issues between both parties in which RESPONSE officer could not discuss due to being in another force. And due to this reporting person would not engage fully.**

Report over concern for a student who is completing lessons over zoom and is screaming and shouting -

- **Parent has been contacted and is now at home. They are awaiting help from partner agencies due to mental health.**

Report of a group of youths climbing a LAMP POST and swinging on exposed wires -

- **RESPONSE officers searched area , but no trace**

Report in regards to reporting person hearing SCREAMING and a MALE SHOUTING

- **RESPONSE officers dispatched. Search of the area made , no trace of anything suspicious and there has been no further reports.**

Report in from a health worker in regards to one of her patients. Health worker is at the address and is getting no answer. Spare key is at the neighbours but they are on holiday. Got access to the rear of the property to find that patient and partner are not in , but there is a small amount of blood on the bed.

- **No deployment**

Report in regards to issues between two parties and a threat of smashing windows in of reporting persons address

- **REPNSE officers have tried to contact Reporting person , without success. But when officer got in contact , reporting person did not want to talk about it at that moment**

Report in regards to a MALE walking around bleeding from the head

- **PCSO ROBERTSON had seen this male previously with no head injury on his patrols , but did look under the influence (no reason to stop and question) RESPONSE officers dispatched and the male is fine , he is with family and is going home**

Report in regards to ongoing HARRASSMENT (no further details)

- **Has been closed down by 101**

Report from social services over concerns for a child due to parent being arrested

- **RESPONSE officers dispatched and small child is safe and well**

Report of builders who are working on next doors property hurling abuse at the reporting person -

- **PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct reassurance visit**

Report over concern for reporting persons daughter wanting to hurt herself.

- **RESPONSE officers dispatched as AMBULANCE is on a 6 hour wait. SAFEGUARDING has been put into place. PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct reassurance visit**

Report in regards to neighbours Dogs damaging fence

- **PCSO ROBERTSON will conduct a REASSURANCE visit**

Report of a Male being aggressive on reporting persons door and shouting for the male to come out of the property

- **RESPONSE officers dispatched and spoke to all parties involved , as there was an issue that had caused this which officers were notified off.**

Report in regards to banging and noises coming from a neighbours address who is away

- **REPNSE officers deployed and property checked—all secure**

MOULTON

FRAUD

Report in regards to threats being made and asking for money to be sent over SNAPCHAT. If money was not sent then police would be contacted, in which therefore over £3000 was sent

- **RESPONSE** officers spoke to reporting person and were investigating however, reporting person wanted to make no further complaint.

THEFT

Report in regards to a payment being made into the wrong persons account and they will not transfer it to the reporting person

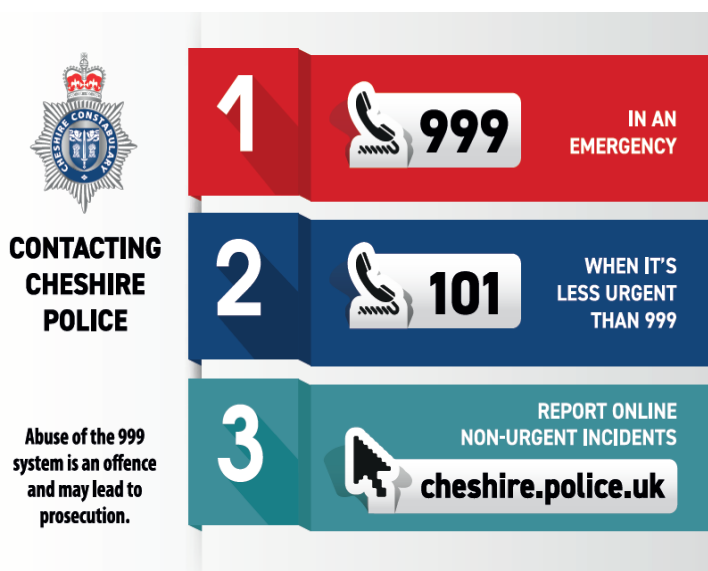

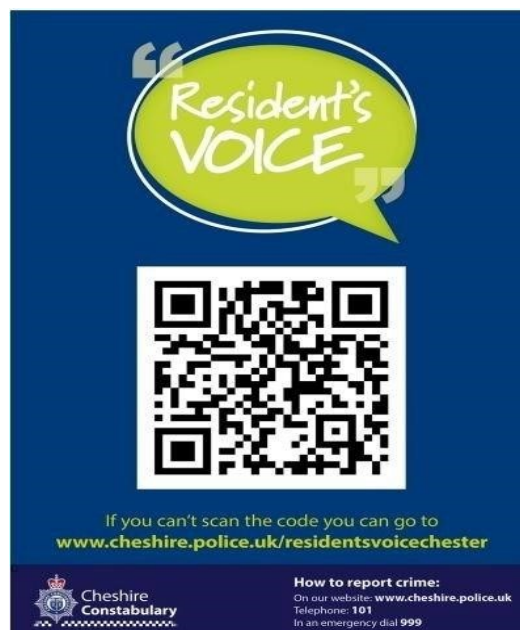

WEAVER HALL / ROSE MEADOW

- More Patrols in area as there is ASB issues (**No Reports of ASB within the area—2nd month running**)
- NEW (FEB) - Speeding on LONDON ROAD—**Speeding will be looked into after EASTER**
- **NEW (MAR) - People smoking cannabis whilst walking down by the RIVER WEAVER—on foot patrols will be happening around the area after EASTER**

LEFTWICH PREVIOUS ISSUES



- Speed Monitoring on CLIFTON DRIVE / DUNHAM ROAD / LONDON ROAD (30MPH SECTION) and LIME AVE—Speed Camera Sessions will be up and running soon
- More Visibility around WOODPECKER DRIVE area / GRANVILLE ROAD area
- More patrols around the shops due to ASB issues
- CLIFTON DRIVE IS NOW CLASSED AS A HOTSPOT DUE TO ISSUES THAT HAVE BEEN REPORTED AND PATROLS ARE NOW IN PLACE WITH YOUTHS BEING ASKED TO MOVE ON
- Provide something for the youths to be involved in —this is being looked into as we use to have a YOUTH CLUB operating in MOULTON but we just need a building to hold something and put something on
- (JAN) —We need more visibility especially around CLIFTON DRIVE— PATROLS are occurring when PCSO ROBERTSON is on duty. POLICE SURGERIES will now take place in HOT SPOTS and CLIFTON DRIVE will be one of the new locations that will start middle of FEB
- (JAN) - Drug dealers and Drug Use—We actively seeking INTEL / INFORMATION in regards to this and actively work with the community / partner agencies to deal with this. And any good results are always posted on our social media channels. PCSO ROBERTSON has actively been involved with 2 operations with one person being evicted from property and another arrested.
- (FEB) - There should be a ONE WAY SYSTEM around the SCHOOL PICKUP area—Will pass these concerns to RACHEL WATERMAN who is the CWAC representative for LEFTWICH
- FEB—Speeding on DUNHAM ROAD— Speeding will be looked into just like parking , this will happen after EASTER

NEW ISSUES

- (APR)—Slow Drivers — Unfortunately if people are being safe on roads by reducing their speed , this is not a police matter. This is what we want to happen to keep everyone safe on roads
- (APR) - Keep young people safe—we do attend schools and give out talks / presentations to schools , when schools request them. When there is ASB issues patrols are put into place to prevent further ASB. If there are people known to us involved in ASB or anything else , home visits with chats with parents present does take place.
- (APR) Drug related issues—any information about this , should be passed to 101 / CRIMESTOPPERS or your local policing team via emails which are on the first page of the newsletter
- (APR) Gangs of Teens causing issues—we are aware of issues on CLIFTON DRIVE reason why patrols in place. But further issues need to be reported to 101

KINGSMEAD

PREVIOUS ISSUES

- Speed Monitoring on REGENCY WAY and DUKES WAY—Will be included in the MINI POLICE PROGRAM
- More Patrols around REGENCY WAY RETAIL PARK
- Littering from the students that attend SIR JOHN DEANES—this will be looked into by the MINI POLICE
- Anti Social Behaviour issues around the community—No issues reported since OCTOBER
- (DEC) Parking on DRIVEWAYS , people should park on their driveways and not on the road— PCSO Robertson will look into this in the next few weeks to see if there are obstructions caused
- (JAN) - More parking patrols especially around RESIDENTIAL AREAS—PCSO ROBERTSON is doing parking patrols in areas that have been notified to himself via 101 and RESIDENTS VOICE
- (FEB) - On Foot patrols around RIVER WEAVER due to littering
- (NOV) More Parking patrols around the area— as you can see from front page, parking is being looked at
- (NOV) Bring up issues relating to CANNANBIS to WEAVER VALE—Are in touch with WEAVER VALE and will raise this up again



NEW ISSUES

- (APR) Vehicles getting damaged — This should be reported to 101. How are they getting damaged ? There has been no CRIMINAL DAMAGE reports in regards to vehicles in the KINGSMEAD AREA
- (APR) To prevent ANTI SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR—we do attend schools and give out talks / presentations to schools , when schools request them. When there is ASB issues patrols are put into place to prevent further ASB. But if there are issues of ASB they would need to be reported to 101
- (APR) Noisy Vehicles that make a huge noise when being revved— Unfortunately vehicle specifications are not down to the police , but however if there is a vehicle that has been customized and is making excessive noise this would need to be reported to 101 , with vehicle details
- (APR) Car parked on BICKLEY CLOSE and has not moved for past 3 months—There is a time scale that we need to adhere to before possible abandoned cars are reported to the local council. As this vehicle is approaching the deadline of being abandoned it will be reported to CWAC , by PCSO ROBERTSON

PREVIOUS ISSUES

- (NOV) - Speed Monitoring on MOUNT PLEASANT / FOUNTAIN LANE / LONDON ROAD (20 MPH SECTION) / HARTFORD ROAD) and CHURCH ROAD at commuter times—community speed watch is restarting soon—JAN
- Provide events / things to do for the youths in the community— We are actively working with partner agencies to look into running youth events—please keep an eye on our social media channels
- (NOV) 20MPH Signage is in the wrong areas as there is a lot of speeding in the area — Community Speed watch has now been set up and ready for its 1st session
- FEB—Parking on Footpaths Parking on footpaths is allowed—HOWEVER a pram and wheelchair must still be able to get passed and each area will be looked into as some roads / paths were not made for todays vehicles to be fully parked on roads.

PREVIOUS ISSUES

- (FEB) - Speed Monitoring on MAIN ROAD / WHITLOW LANE—Speed Gun sessions are re-starting after EASTER
- Speed Gun Sessions not just JACK LANE
- More Visibility around the YARDLEY AVE / RAVENSCROFT areas
- FEB—Inconsiderate parking around the VILLAGE—we are aware of the REGENT STREET BACKS issues which are now putting more vehicles onto the road. Area is placed on PATROL PLAN
- MAR- Regent street backs planning development conditions have not been met and development should not commence—Unfortunately this is not a POLICE MATTER this would have to be brought up to CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER COUNCIL and the PARISH COUNCIL. We have brought up residents concerns in regards to parking and traffic management to the PARISH COUNCIL whilst the development is being conducted.



NEW ISSUES

- (APR)- A crack down on bad driving / speeding and parking to make our roads safer — When it comes to bad driving if there are issues with a certain vehicle , this would need to be reported to 101 , with vehicle details ,as police cant patrol all roads. When a report comes in , this then gets passed to ALL PATROLS to look out of the vehicle. When it comes to speeding , which roads are the concern, so speed monitoring can take place. Parking , we do understand parking in MOULTON is an issue at present with the developments taking place , but we are still patrolling area for bad obstructions.
- (APR) Parking—REGENT STREET—We understand due to the development that parking has been impacted , however there is the car park next to the park , which we have been informed by PARISH COUNCIL , can be used

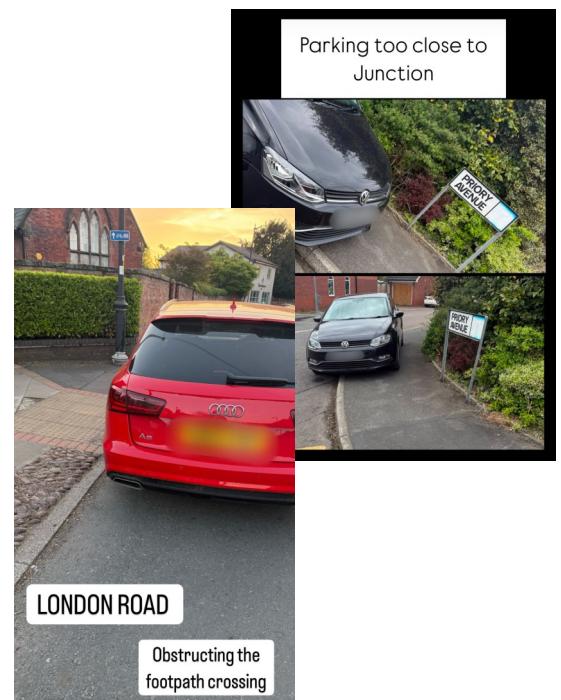

MINI POLICE GO FOR GOLD

Over the EASTER BREAK , Northwich Police worked alongside BRIO LEISURE CENTRE to provide activities for the MINI POLICE to attend. This relationship between BRIO and NORTHWICH POLICE is to try and bring back youth events back to Northwich. As a try out the first event that was set up was the "GOING FOR GOLD BLEEP TEST CHALLENGE"

The Mini Police all take on the 10 meters Bleep Test when they join the Mini Police and get an individual score. This event challenged them to beat their score and to take on Police Officers at the official Police 15 meters Bleep Test.

All Mini Police around the community was invited , including RUDHEATH and HARTFORD. And we had Mini Police from KINGSMEAD , DAVENHAM and HARTFORD attend the event and take on the challenge.

The level that Police Officers have to achieve is 5.2 . 88% of MINI POLICE who attended achieved that level and go on to obtain scores of 10+ , which put some of our officers to shame.

We even had a younger brother of a Mini Police Officer take on the challenge , and he obtained a score of 11+. Just amazing. Hes a Mini Police officer in the making.
